

MJ PRODUCTIONS

HARVEST HUSTLE

1. By entering all contestants agree to abide by and follow all rules.
2. Pre-Entries must be completed by October 20th @ 9 pm.
3. Online entries for pre-draw will close October 20th @ 9 pm.
4. Late Entries will be taken after with a late fee of \$10.
5. Draw out deadline to receive refund minus office fee October 20th @ 9 pm.
6. Substitution & Buyout deadline October 20th @ 9 pm.
7. Can substitute horse or rider, but not both. A \$10 substitution fee will be charged.
8. After the draw is complete, no refunds will be issued.
9. Once pre entries close an approximate start time will be determined for the goat tying.
10. NO AWARDS WILL BE MAILED. PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY!
11. Run Order: Contestants MUST run horses in draw order. A failure to do this will result in a disqualification. Riders may not switch their horses' positions. Horses must run as they appear in the draw.
12. Exhibitions: Exhibitions will be sold on a first come first serve basis. An online link will be available on MJ Productions facebook page. The 60 second time limit will be enforced. Exhibitions going over 60 seconds will be assessed a \$10 penalty.
13. Timers: Two electric eyes will be used. Reruns will be given only in the event of a timer malfunction and all penalties from the original run will carry over. If a rerun is given, it will be up to the show manager to decide when the rerun will take place. Reruns will not be given for horses falling, contestants' equipment breaking, or for a rider's decision to pull up.
14. Drags: There will be a drag after every 5 runs and a drag before each "new section." The big drags will be posted before the race starts.
15. Disqualification: Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be ready will result in a disqualification. If a horse runs out of order, it will be disqualified.

16. Open 3D Poles: \$45 entry fee. 3D format; 1 second splits. A tipped pole will receive a 5 second penalty. Prizes awarded.
17. Youth Poles: \$30 entry fee. 2D format; 1 second splits. 16 & under age as of Jan. 1st of the current year. A Tipped pole will receive a 5 second penalty. Prizes awarded.
18. Combo Barrel and Pole Draw: BOTH open and youth poles will run together in one combined draw.
19. Open Barrel Race: \$1,000 added (\$500 each day) \$55 entry fee per day. 5D format ½ sec. splits. Separate payout both days, prizes awarded to average. A tipped barrel will be considered a no time. No two people may ride the same horse in the same class.
20. 3D Youth Barrel Race: \$35 entry fee. 3D format 1 sec. splits. 9-16 years of age or younger as of Jan. 1st of current year. All youth will run together in the Open Combo Draw. You MUST designate if carrying a time over before entries close. A tipped barrel will result in a no time. Separate payout both days, awards on average.
21. Peewee Barrel Race: 2D format 1 second split. 8 yrs and younger as of Jan 1st of current year. Contestants may run in peewee OR youth but NOT both.
22. Senior Sidepot: \$30 entry fee. 2D format 0.75 sec. split. Open for anyone 50+ as of Jan 1st of current year. Must run in the open and carry over time to the sidepot. A tipped barrel will result in a no time. Separate payout both days, awards on average.
23. Futurity Sidepot: \$30 entry fee. 2D format 1 sec split. For horses born in 2020 and 2021 (4 and 5 years of age). Futurity horses must run in Open and carry over to the sidepot.
24. Derby Sidepot: \$30 entry fee. 2D format 0.75 sec split. For horses born in 2017-2020 (5 to 8 years of age) Horses are not allowed to enter the futurity and derby the same year. Horses must run in open and carry over to the sidepot.
25. Novice Horse Sidepot: \$30 entry fee. 2D format 1 sec split. For horses who LTE's have not exceeded \$500 as of entry deadline date. Novice horses must run in Open and carry over to the sidepot.
26. Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash. We also ask you to clean up after them.
27. Dress Code: No dress code.

28. Zero Tolerance Policy: Abuse includes but is not limited to; excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, slapping, abuse with a device or any other act intended to cause trauma or injury to a horse in the arena, practice pen, or on grounds.

Abusers will be asked to leave the grounds forfeiting any and all fees or winnings.

29. MJ Productions reserves the right to refuse any entry, draw out contestants at any given time, at their discretion with or without notifying the contestant or horse owner ahead of time.

30. MJ Productions reserves the right to alter, change and modify these rules at any time. If a disagreement arises, MJ Productions holds the right to the final decision.

31. AWARDS WILL NOT BE MAILED. YOU MUST PICK THEM UP OR HAVE SOMEONE GRAB THEM FOR YOU. IF NOTHING HAS BEEN ARRANGED WITH THE OFFICE AND NO ONE IS AROUND TO PICK UP YOUR AWARD, THE AWARD WILL BE FORFEITED. PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY.
